

## ROYAL CANOE CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT JUNIOR MEMBERS – ATHELETES & PARENTS

The Royal Canoe Club supports the core values of the sport - commitment, ownership, responsibility and excellence.

Junior members of the Club have an opportunity to develop both as an athlete and as an individual and improve your sport and yourself. Therefore it is important that you represent yourself, your club and your sport appropriately by behaving responsibly. Parents have the responsibility to help the Junior members understand and follow this Code of Conduct. This Code of Conduct is to ensure all junior members know the standards of behaviour expected of them when involved with Club activities. This will help the volunteers, coaches and staff at the Club look after you and make sure that every junior member is able to enjoy paddling and their time at the Club.

- Behaviour onsite must be becoming to a Royal Canoe Club member be polite, courteous, considerate and respectful to all people, paddlers and water users - treat everyone with the same respect and fairness as you would want them to show you.
- All paddlers should be able to participate in canoeing without fear of ridicule, harassment or restriction.
- Control your temper and avoid behaviour which may affect, offend or upset others.
- Demonstrate fair play on and off the water. Respect differences in gender, disability, culture, race, ethnicity and religious beliefs between yourself and others.
- Challenge discrimination, prejudice and behaviour that falls below the expected standards of the Club.
- Look out for yourself and the welfare of others. Speak confidentially to Club Welfare Officers or email at welfare@royalcanoeclub.com
- Do not engage in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour.

- Take care of and respect any property and equipment belonging to the club or any club member. Please ensure the following:
  - 1. No equipment/ boats are removed from site without the permission of RCC Crew Boats crewboats@royalcanoeclub.com
  - 2. Report any equipment failure to <a href="mailto:boatrepairs@royalcanoeclub.com">boatrepairs@royalcanoeclub.com</a>
  - 3. Do not leave wet kit in the changing rooms and do not wear wet kit in the clubroom.
- Be organised, on time and ready for training sessions and events.
- Junior members may only be present on Club premises when accompanied by an adult or the nominated coach for their session.
- Do not leave a coaching session without the knowledge and permission of the coach
- Listen to and co-operate fully, respecting all requests and decisions made by the coaches. They have your best interests and those of the whole group in mind.
- Do not smoke, consume alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst on club premises or representing the club at events.
- Advise the coach of any medical conditions which may affect your standard of canoeing.
- Follow the Club rules
